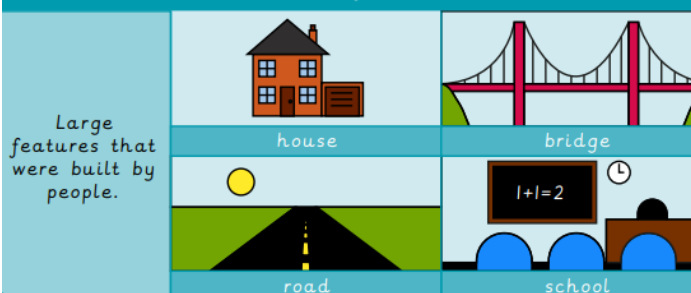
Key Knowledge

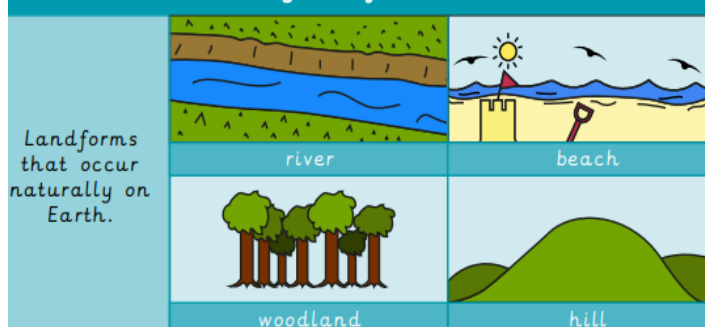
